This training program started for developing skill among the women and youth for opening avenues for their employment opportunities and to help them to start their own enterprise for their earning and sustainable agricultural practices.



SOCIAL PROGRAMME:

Help to poor

Our vision is to help the needy and poor people through its social welfare programme, where it has undertaken financial assistance, cloth distribution and food distribution programme for them in its operational area. It seeks to capacitate socially and economically disadvantaged people.

Games & Sports

Games and sports it is not only physical exercise, it is a mental exercise, exercise of freshness, exercise of removing frustration. It increases concentration power for students and the youth. For this purpose we have organized sports event on racing, kabadi, football and other for the school children.



Annual Celebration (Raksha Bandhan)

The organization has organized padajatra and cultural programme on the occasion of Raksha Bandhan. Its relevance extends beyond familial bonds, as it promotes cultural diversity and social harmony. Irrespective of caste and creed people from all walks of life participated in this celebration.

Napkin Distribution

We have distributed Sanitary Napkin to the adolescent girls for Menstrual Health Management and sensitize them to maintain hygiene and not taking any medicine without Doctor's advice.

EDUCATION PROGRAMME:

We offer free coaching classes for the children who are going to school by assisting them in completing their homework and enhancing their hidden skills and talents. People from different walks of life including volunteers have joined our initiative conferring them with equal opportunity for molding their future. This feature has embarked in ensuring that children belonging to poor families are not neglected of proper education due to lack of financial resources.

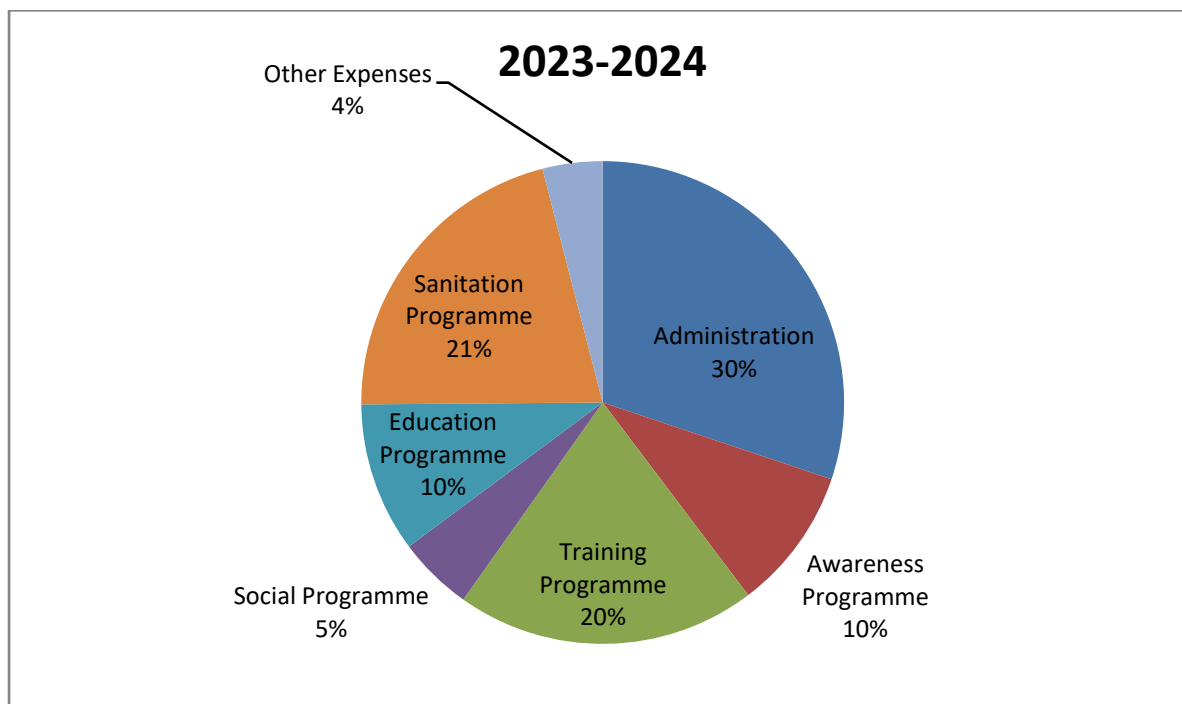
Objective: The major development objective of this programme is to improve the quality and accessibility of education by improving access to early learning and developmental facilities, young children are better prepared for their primary school education.

**SANITATION PROGRAMME:**

Lack of adequate sanitation forces households into the continued indignity of open defecation, which is an acute problem especially for women and young girls. Improving access to sanitation is therefore an important need for the rural people.

Sanitation for poor households has been extended under this programme for clean environment and hygienic prevention for their family as well as to make understand others the need for such sanitation to be replicated.
